

On 9/21/12 I Union County Sheriff's Deputy met with Union County States Attorney, Tyler Edmonds, and Deputy John Theriac at the sheriff's office. Both stated to me that a female identified as Mary K Baggott had come to the sheriff's office and stated that she had been held against her will by her estranged husband (identified as Tim J. Baggott) at their marital residence at [REDACTED] in rural [REDACTED].

Myself, and Deputy Theriac were requested to go to the aforementioned residence and take Tim Baggott into custody on the charge of Aggravated Unlawful Restraint. Theriac, and myself arrived at the residence above. Tim Baggott came to the door. We identified ourselves, and told him he was under arrest for the above charge. He was informed that it was involving the incident with his wife (Mary) from earlier in the day involving a shotgun. Baggott stated to us that "it wasn't a shotgun, it was a 22 rifle. Tim Baggott was taken into custody without incident, and transported to the sheriff's office. Baggott was later processed, and transported to the Jackson County Jail in Murphysboro.

Interview's with both Mary, and Tim Baggott were conducted at the sheriff's office. Upon conclusion of the interview with Mary, I followed her to the [REDACTED] residence in order for her to secure it, retrieve medication for Tim, and to take firearms into evidence. Prior to going into the residence Mary signed a Permission to Search form. (see attached copy)

Taken into evidence were the following items:

- (1) Springfield 20 ga. pump shotgun
- (1) Marlin 22 rifle with 14 rounds of ammunition ( with one round jammed in revolver)
- (1) Hawkins 50 caliber black powder rifle.
- (2) Boxes of 20 ga. shotgun shells.

Mary signed an evidence receipt for the aforementioned items, and I provided her with a copy. It should be noted that along with the 3 firearms that were located on a gun rack in the computer room, there was a pellet rifle that Mary stated belonged to one of their son's. She took possession of this item herself. Photograph's were taken of the bedroom in which the incident was to have occurred.

## Interview with Mary K. Baggott

A video recorded interview was conducted with Mary K. Baggott at the sheriff's office regarding the reported incident involving her husband Tim.

Mary stated that she and Tim have been married for approximately 18 years. They have 3 children together. [REDACTED], age 15 years. [REDACTED], age 11 years, and [REDACTED], age 9.

Mary, and Tim have been separated since approximately May of this year. Mary now residence at [REDACTED]. Mary stated that on this day she met with Tim at their house at [REDACTED] to discuss divorce arrangements. Mary stated that she had told Tim approximately 2 days earlier that she was not going to return to the marriage, and wanted a divorce.

Mary said she arrived there at around 9:30am. They went to their bedroom where they began talking about the divorce. She again told Tim that it was over, and she would not be coming back home. Mary stated that Tim said "Is that your decision"?, and she stated yes.

Tim then exited a bedroom door that led into their computer room. He told Mary to wait there, he had a print out he wanted her to look at. Tim returned through another door on the other side of the room with what she describes as a shotgun. Tim had the gun down to his side, and began walking towards her. Mary said Tim reached behind her, and shut the door that led into the computer room. Mary said she was now backed into a corner, and could not leave. Tim was standing between her and the other door with the gun.

Tim began yelling at her, telling her this was all her fault. Mary stated at this point she feared for her life, and thought Tim may shoot her. After Tim yelled at her more, she said it became apparent that he was talking about shooting himself.

Mary stated at this time she told Tim that she would return home, and they would not get a divorce. Tim then relaxed, and went and put the gun back on the gun rack in the computer room. At this time Mary said they began talking about the kids, and other things. After a while she left to attend to their children.

Mary said Tim called her later, and wanted to meet her up town Anna to watch the parade. Mary said that Tim met her, and her mother in front of the Moose Lodge on Main St. in Anna to watch the

On the morning of Friday 9-21-12 I met with my husband Tim Baggett to discuss details of our divorce, we have been separated for ~~at~~ mos, since May of 2012. He questioned me + asked me to come back and I refused. We talked about a few details like selling the house + he kept asking me to return home. I said for a final time that I was not coming back and he said "is that it, you're done?" and I said yes. He said "wait here, I have a printout I want to show you" He went into the computer room which is adjacent to our bedroom, where we were having the conversation. He returned with a shotgun, holding it straight up + down + behind his back. He closed the door that was behind him + was yelling for me to sit down on the bed, I yelled back that I would not + for him to put the gun away. He kept saying that he was serious + this is what I had done him too. I finally pleaded with him to put the gun away, I told him I would pack all my things + be back tonight. He asked me to promise to come back + said I could not tell anyone and not to call the police. After he put the gun away he said he had prepared himself to go, said his goodbyes to the kids this morning. He said he knew when he dropped them off for school, this would be the last time he saw them. After

## Interview with Timothy J. Baggott

A video interview was conducted with Tim Baggott at the Union County Sheriff's Office. Present in the interview were Tim Baggott, Jonesboro Police Officer Kyle McDaniel, and myself Bart Hileman.

Prior to the interview Tim signed a Miranda Rights Waiver, and agreed for the interview to be video recorded.

Tim confirmed that he, and Mary met at the [REDACTED] residence to discuss the terms of their divorce. Tim confirmed that he, and Mary were in their bedroom talking. Time stated that he left the bedroom through the door which exits into the living room, walked to the computer room where he retrieved a 22 caliber rifle that he had, and kept loaded, then returned to the bedroom through the door in which he stated he left through. I asked Tim if the door that led from the bedroom, directly to the computer was shut, and he stated yes. I asked how it got shut, and he stated he did not know.

Tim stated when he returned to the bedroom he had the rifle down to his side, and that he had no intention of hurting Mary. Tim said that he was planning to shoot himself, rather than live without her, and go through a divorce.

Tim said that he did not keep Mary from leaving the room. Tim said she could have left at anytime. Tim said that when Mary stated that she would return to him, he went back, and placed the rifle back on the rack. Tim said they talked a while about the children, and agreed to meet up for the parade later. He did say that they did meet up town Anna for the parade and watched it together.

After the parade was over Tim said he went to Associated Lumber in Anna where he got a new house key made for Mary. He said he then went home to await her return to him.

Tim again stated that he would not harm Mary, and that he was only going to shoot himself. He states he still loves her, and want their marriage to workout.

Upon conclusion of the interview the recorded disk was removed from the recorder, and placed into evidence at the sheriff's office. Tim Baggott was then returned to the holding cell to await transport to the Jackson County Jail.
