




On 08/24/15 at approximately 2:50 P.M., I, Deputy J. Schildknecht met with Donald Biggs on Cox Ln., in rural Dongola about a property dispute.

Upon speaking with Biggs, he advised me has an easement to a cemetery on property owned by Steven D. Yates and Jim Neuman. Biggs advised that the property owners are denying access by a locked gate across the easement. Mr. Biggs showed me paperwork that appeared to be official documents from the county describing the property and the easement, which I photographed and attached to this report. I advised Biggs that this was a civil matter, however I would attempt to contact the property owners and do a report.

I later contacted Steve Yates, one of the property owners. Yates advised me that Biggs can access the easement anytime he wants, however he needs to come ask for a key, or walk around the gate. Yates went on to state that he did not want Biggs on the property by himself because he has destroyed and removed property in the past. Yates also advised he did not want Biggs driving onto the property. I advised Yates I would be completing a report and it would be on file.
