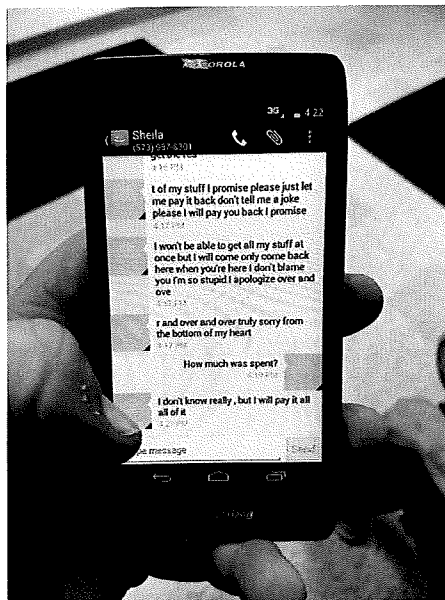
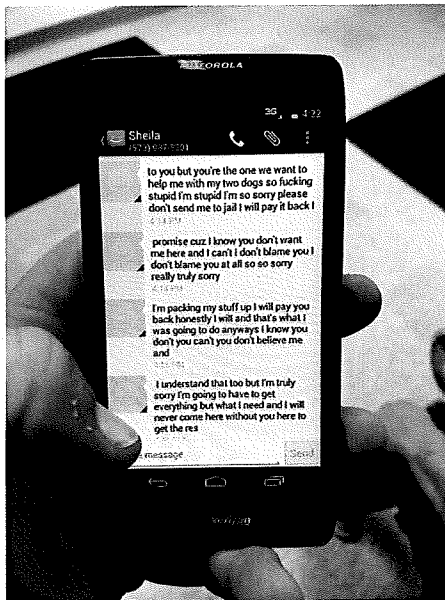
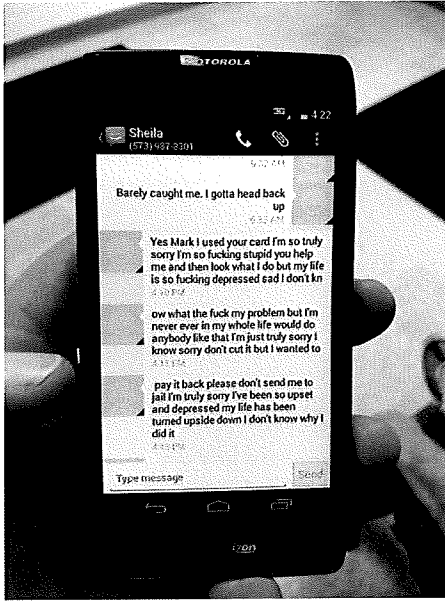

On 10/02/17 at approximately 4:00 P.M., I, Deputy J. Schildknecht met with Mark A. Clover at the Sheriff's Office.

Clover stated his first cousin, Sheila E. Bass, took his Discover card from his residence without his permission and used it at several different locations. He stated he became aware of this when Discover called him and asked him if he was using his card on Priceline.

While I was speaking with Clover he received text messages from Bass stating that she had taken and used the card, that she was sorry, and would pay him back and asking him not to send her back to jail. I photographed the text messages and attached them to this report.

Clover then spoke with a representative from Discover and learned that Bass has spent \$2045.83.
