Please consider this our response to your attached November 9, 2015 Freedom of Information Act request, summarized below:

*My name is Jessie C. Goines and I am requesting police reports involving myself and XXXXXXXXXXXX.*

Please find attached the following reports UC140216007 and UC140116001 with the following redactions:

- The names of the victims have been redacted as they are exempted under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c)) as approved by the Office of the Attorney General in pre-authorization letter 2011 PAC 12171.
- Dates of birth have been redacted as that information is exempt under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c)) as approved by the Office of the Attorney General in pre-authorization letter 2011 PAC 13577.
- Home addresses, personal telephone numbers, driver's license numbers and personal license plate numbers are defined as personal information in Section 2(c-5) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/2(c-5)) and per Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b)) are exempted.
- The names of third parties who were never arrested or were incidentally mentioned in police reports are exempted under Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c)) as approved by the Office of the Attorney General in pre-authorization letter 2011 PAC 12140.
- Photos of the victim have been redacted as we have determined that releasing them would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy as described in Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA (5 ILCS 140/7(1)(c)).



### PRELIMINARY REPORT

Date: 2/06/14

The purpose of this report is to document the violation of Order of Protection 2013-OP-5 by the respondent Jessie Goines.

Order of Protection 2013-OP-5 was issued from the First Judicial Circuit of Union County. The Petitioner is [REDACTED] and Goines were involved in a Domestic Incident on 1/14/14 at their share residence at [REDACTED]. This incident generated Union County Sheriff's Office case number UC1401-16-001. The Order of Protection is effective until February 13th, 2014.

I took a phone call from Marci Malner with the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services. Malner gave me information that she had received from [REDACTED] ( who is currently temporary residing in the state of Florida) that Goines had created a Facebook account under the fictitious name of Jamie Lions, and has been sending messages to [REDACTED].

Malner provided me with [REDACTED]'s Facebook account login, and password in order for me to view the messages.

I logged into [REDACTED]'s account with the given identification, and password. In the message bin of her Facebook page was several typed messages to [REDACTED].

Content of the messages were about attempting to get [REDACTED] to talk to him. He wrote of their child, and their relationship issues. In three of the messages he posted a photograph of himself in what appeared to be preforming oral sex on an unidentified female. It mentions in the messages that he wants her to call him at his grandmothers residence at the phone number of [REDACTED].

At the end of his spree of messages he appears to become angry, and appears he threatens her with court, and posting photograph's of her.

The messages started at 1:26am, and stated "today" on the side of the format. It appears Goines had sent [REDACTED] approximately 50 messages on this date. The last message was posted at 8:15pm.

I photographed each message from Goines, and attached them with this preliminary report.

This investigation is ongoing.

On the date in question Jessie Goines was arrested on a warrant for Aggravated Stalking by Union County Sheriff's Deputy Larry Clover. Goines was transported to the Union County Sheriff's Office where he was processed, and placed in detention.

I removed Jessie from the detention area, and escorted him to an interview room at the sheriff's office. I read Jessie Goines his Miranda Rights, and he signed a waiver of his rights.

I began an interview with him regarding the accusations, and information regarding him contacting his estranged wife, [REDACTED].

At this time Jessie evoked his right to have his attorney present during the interview. I stopped the interview, and returned him to the detention area. Jessie was later transported to the Jackson County Jail in Murphysboro IL.

Upon completion of the interview, a DVD of the recorded interview was placed into evidence.

On the above date, and approximate time I conducted an video recorded interview with Jessie Goines with the presents of his attorney, Gary Stark.

Prior to the start of the interview I read Jessie his Miranda Rights. Jessie signed a waiver of his rights, and agreed to the interview.

Jessie Goines admitted to the following incidents in which he had either contacted, or attempted to contact his estranged wife, [REDACTED].

Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 12:03am (CDT) Jessie accessed a dormant Facebook account of [REDACTED] with his cellphone in order to possibly obtain information that would aid in his civil case with [REDACTED]. Jessie said he was going to give any information he discovered to his Attorney. Jessie denies that he was attempting contact [REDACTED] in order to talk to her.

Jessie admitted that he has in the past used false Facebook accounts in order to contact [REDACTED] or obtain information about [REDACTED]. Jessie stated he has used the following names on Facebook, Julie Dish (April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014) Paul Andrews (February 2014) [REDACTED] (a male friend of [REDACTED]).

Jessie had accessed [REDACTED] Pintrest account in late March of 2014.

Jessie admitted to contacting [REDACTED] father, [REDACTED] via cellphone in April 2014.

Goines admits to using internet applications that show calls, and text messages from different phone numbers.

Goines stated that on one occasion [REDACTED] had him a Facebook request. Jessie said that he accepted the request by accident, then deleted her from his Facebook page. Jessie said this was not intentional.

He also had Facebook correspondence with a friend of [REDACTED] identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Jessie said he represented himself as a friend of [REDACTED], identified as [REDACTED] through electronic means.

Of the aforementioned events that Jessie Goines admitted to, he remains firm that he did not strike or hit her in any way on the initial incident that prompted a law enforcement response to their residence.

Jessie Goines signed three Consent to Search forms in order for investigation's to access information from two of his cellular phones.

For further information regarding the interview with Jessie Goines, see copy of attached DVD labeled Interview with Jessie Goines (5/02/14). The original DVD was placed into evidence at the sheriff's office.

On the above date I Deputy Bart Hileman secured two search warrants for the cellphones of Jessie Goines. Both phones had been taken as evidence in connection with the Order of Protection violation, Condition of Bond violation, and Aggravated Stalking charge.

Search warrants were signed by Judge Cavaness of the Court of Union County. The phones were taken to Detective Sgt. Tim Legere of the Jackson County Sheriff's Office in which the information from the phones was downloaded onto compact disk's. Each disk was placed into evidence at the Union County Sheriff's Office. Copies of the CD were produced, and submitted to the sheriff's office case file, and to the Union County State's Attorney.

A copy of the search warrant was left with each phone, and they were placed back into the evidence vault.

The Search Warrant's were returned to the court along with Inventory & Return, and Search Warrant Order.







Red mark approximately center of chest.




Bruising to lower left shoulder. Long mark is a scar, not involved.




Mark on left upper temple.

Report for Incident 2014-000171, Domestic Battery. A call was placed to the Union County Sheriff's Office by the Anna Police Department reporting a Domestic Battery that had taken place at [REDACTED], the R/P stated that he took a gun from the other party. Upon arrival to [REDACTED] a male was seen standing outside who was identified as Jessie C. Goines. Goines stated that he had called the Police and was pointing into some bushes stating he had put the gun in them, but she still has the clip in the house. The firearm which was a black 25 Cal. Pistol was recovered and removed from the scene. I asked Goines to explain what has happened. Goines stated that his wife [REDACTED] needs a mental evaluation and that she just attacks him, forcing him to restrain her. He went on to say that she has this all planned out and is trying to take his child and home from him.

Goines was asked if there was any physical contact between the two on this night. Goines stated that he was bit on the arm, and showed a mark on his right arm. Goines said that he had taken the pistol from [REDACTED] and brought it outside. Goines went on to say that he doesn't feel safe with her in the house and her having access to "the" gun. I then went into the residence to speak with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that when Goines came home, he (Goines)

stated to [REDACTED] that he had spoke to an attorney about a divorce. She said they began talking and that Goines told her that he loved her and didn't want the family to be torn apart.

[REDACTED] said that Goines throughout the night continued asking about a pistol that her father had given her, and wanted to know where it was. She said he first started saying that if she wanted to stay at the house, she needed to show him the pistol. [REDACTED] said she finally showed Goines the pistol which was in the basement and was unloaded. She said the clip, also empty was in a closet in an upstairs bedroom. That is where the clip was recovered. [REDACTED] then said they got ready for bed and had intercourse. This is where [REDACTED] stated that Goines began to try and argue with her, she in turn goes into one of the other bedrooms with the baby and lays down.

At this point Goines enters the bedroom and tells her she could not stay at the house and to "get the fuck out". [REDACTED] stated that Goines pulled her off of the bed by grabbing her legs and pulled her into the floor. She stated that he placed his knee into her chest and as she was trying to roll over, he was striking her in the back of her head. [REDACTED] stated she was struck four to five times. I asked [REDACTED] how she got the mark on her nose. She stated that it was from the carpet where she was trying to roll away from him. It was also noticed that [REDACTED] had a red spot on her chest along with a bruise about the size of a quarter on her lower left shoulder. [REDACTED] said that he got left her alone and went down stairs where he got the pistol and was stating to her "your going down you fucking bitch"

At that point all weapons were gathered from the residence and placed for safe keeping. Weapons removed from the residence were as follows (1)PIC 25 caliber handgun along with the clip and 6 rounds, (1) Marlin 22 caliber rifle (1) Springfield Savage 20 gauge double barrel shotgun, and 31 rounds of Golden Tiger 7.62 MM rounds.

Both parties had explained to them that there is enough probable cause to place both subjects into custody for Domestic Battery. Goines was asked if he had anywhere he could go for at least the night to get away from the situation. Goines stated that he had family in Wetaug that he could go stay with. It was explained to him the he needed to gather clothing and other items that was needed for a day or two and that he needed to go there and not to come back for the night or he would be placed into custody. Goines agreed to the condition. [REDACTED] was left at the residence due to having a 3 month old daughter between the two parties that was being breast feed and relied solo on the mother for nutrition.

I would ask that the State Attorney's Office review this report to determine if any charges are to filed against one or both parties involved.
