Other Theft Over \$300 Pending Investigation

On, 03-16-17, I Deputy Ralls (UC K9-1), responded to 800 Cypress Road for a report of a theft from a residence.

Upon arrival I made contact with the victim, Dann Kraatz. He advised me that he had things missing from his house. He stated that there were too many items missing to mention, but he wanted to show me two items he knew for sure were missing. He described those two items as follows:

Stolen: Winchester Knife set, Value: \$75.00

Stolen: Gold Necklace in case, Value: \$250.00

I asked Dann where the items were located inside the residence. He advised me that the knife set was in his gun room and the necklace was inside his bedroom. I was then advised by Dann that his estranged wife and her brother had been moving things from the house, he also stated that he did not believe that him or her would steal from him and did not think they were suspects. I then asked Dann if he knew who may be responsible for the items missing, at which time he advised me that there had been some "homeless people inside his house" and he thinks that one of them may have taken the items. I asked Dann if he knew who the homeless people were and why they were inside his house, he then asked a female, was present in the room, to tell me who they were. I identified the female as, Becky Brown, and she advised me that the female in question was helping her clean the house. She also advised me that there was a male that was in the house with her, I asked her if she could identify these people for me. She advised me that the female's name was, [REDACTED], and the male was, [REDACTED]. I asked her if [REDACTED] was alone inside the residence or either of these rooms. She told me that it was possible because they spent approximately one hour inside the residence. I then asked Brown if she knew any contact information for [REDACTED] or [REDACTED]. She advised me that all she knew is that they were homeless and were probably staying in Jackson, Mo, she also told me that she did not have any contact information for them. I was also told by Brown that she did not believe that [REDACTED] was a thief, at which time Dann stated "It's has to be her, you had her in the room, use your head."

I then advised Dann that if he noticed any other items missing from the residence to contact me and I would supplement this report. He stated " I know there are things missing, I will call you when I figure it out."

There is nothing further to report at this time.

This case remains open for further investigation.
