Re: Redistricting Data for the Year 2020 Census

The United States Census Bureau has completed their first round of data collection for the 2020 Census, and has informed the State Board of Elections (SBE) that current information has not been received from many Illinois counties. Accurate 2020 Census data comes from accurate GIS data, and the Census Bureau would like to complete the project of realigning the census block boundaries with the accurate locally-sourced geographic boundaries and parcels (GIS data) as soon as practicable. Therefore, the Census Bureau is requesting parcel data and taxing district data from the local jurisdictions. Future updates and boundary line changes may be submitted as they occur, but it is important that current and accurate data is submitted as soon as possible. As the SBE is daily receiving this information, it is being uploaded to the Census Bureau.

In an attempt to have the final project in the cleanest form possible, the following is what the Census Bureau would like to receive:

"The Census Boundary Quality Assessment and Reconciliation Program is looking for administrative boundaries (places, counties, county subdivisions) as well as cadastral data (parcels) as reference. These data are needed in electronic geographic formats (shapefile, geodatabase). In addition, any supporting annexation or de-annexation records would be extremely helpful, especially if there is a known difference between the geographic files being submitted and those boundaries as represented by the Census Bureau. These supporting documents can be in any standard format such as MSWord or PDF."

The best way to submit your GIS data is by placing it in "dropbox" (this is a free application that can be found at www.dropbox.com), and emailing us a link to your data. This can also be submitted to us on a CD or DVD, depending on your amount of data to:
