Report for Incident 2017-002556, Burglary, Case: UC170619036

On June 17th 2017 at approximately 9:39 PM, I (Deputy Tim Goodman) was dispatched to [REDACTED] reference a residential burglary. I arrived on scene shortly after and met with the home owners (identified as [REDACTED] w/m DOB [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] w/f DOB [REDACTED] who stated they had left their home at approximately 8:00AM and returned at approximately 9:39 PM. [REDACTED] stated when she walked inside the house she immediately noticed a gun cabinet which had contained several guns was empty and some of the contents were scattered across the floor in front of the gun cabinet. [REDACTED] stated when she noticed the disturbance, she backed out of the house and called the police.

[REDACTED] then invited me into the home and showed me the gun cabinet near the front door which had been disturbed. [REDACTED] then showed to me another gun cabinet located in a storage room which had also been opened and the guns taken out of it. [REDACTED] then took me to a fire safe in the master bedroom, which had been opened. [REDACTED] stated this fire safe only contained documentation and nothing had been taken from it, however, the door had been opened on it. [REDACTED] then told me the night stand on the other side of his bed had contained a pistol which was missing. [REDACTED] also showed me where 2 jewelry boxes had been sitting.

[REDACTED] was able to provide to me a list of the guns which had been stolen most of which he had the serial numbers for. The guns taken are listed below:

- 1- Mossberg .22 semi auto pink camouflaged rifle
- 1- Benelli Super Black Eagle 2 12 gauge camouflaged (Mossy Oak Break UP) S/N : U240372
- 1-Browning Automatic light 20 gauge black S/N : 11065NW231
- 1- 410 bolt action with poly choke black and tan
- 1-Remington 870 20 gauge youth model black and tan S/N : C602652U
- 1-Mossberg Viking 500 Model 12 gauge with scope, green S/N : F179829
- 1-High Point 9mm black S/N : P1909591
- 1-Thompson Centerfire .50 Caliper Muzzleloader, black and wood

I contacted Illinois State Police Crime Scene Investigators who stated they would investigate the scene the following morning.

[REDACTED] stated prior to leaving their house for the day, he made a Facebook notification which stated he was going out of town for the day.

The [REDACTED] is also informed me during their absence, [REDACTED]'s brother ([REDACTED]) along with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] arrived at the house at approximately 12:30 PM to retrieve a wheel chair. These subjects were allowed to be at the property by the home owner. While they were retrieving the wheel chair, [REDACTED] stated he noticed the gun cabinet was emptied but did not know the house had been burglarized. [REDACTED] stated the living room gun cabinet had not been emptied while they were there.

There are no known suspects at this time.

Investigation is pending.
