**ORDINANCE REDUCING SPEED LIMIT ALONG PART OF THE COUNTY
HIGHWAY KNOWN AS FAS 1926/COUNTY HIGHWAY 2/MAIN STREET/SKYLINE
DRIVE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ALTO PASS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-604(d), upon receipt of an engineering study for the part or zone of highway in question from the county engineer, and notwithstanding any other provision of law, the county board of a county may determine and declare by ordinance a reduction in the maximum speed limit at any place or along any part or zone of a county highway whenever the county board, in its sole discretion, determines that the reduction in the maximum speed limit is reasonable and safe; and

WHEREAS, FAS 1926/County Highway 2/Main Street/Skyline Drive within the Village of Alto Pass, Illinois is a county highway; and

WHEREAS, the county engineer has prepared an engineering study regarding FAS 1926/County Highway 2/Main Street/Skyline Drive within the Village of Alto Pass, Illinois and such engineering study has been received and reviewed by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois finds a reduction in the maximum speed limit along that part of FAS 1926/County Highway 2/Main Street/Skyline Drive within the Village of Alto Pass, Illinois is reasonable and safe and that the health, safety and welfare of the People of the County of Union, Illinois will be promoted and protected by imposing such a reduction in the maximum speed limit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UNION, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2:

- (a) The maximum speed limit on that part of the county highway known as FAS 1926/County Highway 2/Main Street/Skyline Drive within the Village of Alto Pass, Illinois between Cedar Street and Walnut Street shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
- (b) The maximum speed limit on that part of the county highway known as FAS 1926/County Highway 2/Main Street/Skyline Drive within the Village of Alto Pass,

Illinois between Walnut Street and Illinois State Route 127 shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

- (c) The county engineer shall post signs designating the speed limits as set in Subsections (a) and (b).

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
