**ORDINANCE TO SET FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE
OF CIVIL UNION LICENSE**

WHEREAS, the County of Union, Illinois currently charges a fee of \$25 for the issuance of a marriage license, the certificate thereof, and the recording of same; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly, pursuant to Public Act 96-1513, effective June 1, 2011, has provided procedures for the certification and registration of a civil union and provide persons entering into a civil union with the obligations, responsibilities, protections, and benefits afforded or recognized by the law of Illinois to spouses.

WHEREAS, Public Act 96-1513 requires that the County Clerk receive applications and issue certificates for civil unions in the same manner as applications are received and certificates issued in regard to marriage; and


WHEREAS, Public Act 96-1513 contemplates s that fees should be paid for the services provided by the County Clerk in regard to the of a civil union license, the certificate thereof, and the recording of same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UNION, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: That the fee imposed and collected by the County Clerk for the issuance of each civil union license, the certificate thereof, and the recording of same, shall be \$25.00; and

SECTION 2: That imposition of said fee shall commence June 1, 2011.


