**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN FEES  
OF THE UNION COUNTY SHERIFF**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/4-5001, a county board may by ordinance, increase certain fees of the sheriff and collect those increased fees from all persons and entities other than officers, agencies, departments and other instrumentalities of the State if the increase is justified by an acceptable cost study showing that the fees allowed by 55 ILCS 5/4-5001 are not sufficient to cover the costs of providing the service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois has engaged the firm of Hudgens & Meyer, LLC, Certified Public Accounts, to conduct a cost study regarding the costs of providing certain services by the Union County Sheriff (the "Cost Study"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Cost Study and all supporting documents are public records and subject to public examination and audit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cost Study include examination and consideration of all direct and indirect costs, as defined in the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois finds that, based upon a review of the Cost Study, increases in the fees charged for certain services of the Union County Sheriff are justified because the current fees are insufficient to cover the costs of providing the services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UNION, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2:** The Union County Code is hereby amended by deleting Section 1 of Article 14 of Chapter 36 in its entirety and replacing such Section as follows:

## SHERIFF'S FEES


### 36-14-1 Sheriff's Fees.

- (a) Fees of the Union County Sheriff shall be as follows:
  - (1) For taking special bail, one-hundred dollars (\$100).
  - (2) For taking all bonds on legal process, civil and criminal, one-hundred dollars (\$100).
  - (3) For serving or attempting to serve summons on each defendant, seventy dollars (\$70).
  - (4) For serving or attempting to serve an order or judgment granting injunctive relief, seventy dollars (\$70).
  - (5) For serving or attempting to serve each garnishee, seventy dollars (\$70).
  - (6) For serving or attempting to serve an order for replevin, seventy dollars (\$70).
  - (7) For serving or attempting to serve an order for attachment on each defendant, seventy dollars (\$70).
  - (8) For serving or attempting to serve a subpoena on each witness, seventy dollars (\$70).
  - (9) For serving or attempting to serve any other civil court document not listed in this Section, seventy dollars (\$70).
- (b) All monies collected pursuant to Subsection (a)(1) and Subsection (a)(2) of this Section shall be non-refundable and shall be in addition to the amount of bond ordered by the court.
- (c) The Sheriff shall remit all monies collected pursuant to this Section to the Treasurer.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.






