**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ARTICLE 12 OF CHAPTER
36 OF THE UNION COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING CHILD
ADVOCACY CENTER FEE PURSUANT TO 55 ILCS 5/5-1101**

WHEREAS, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-1101(f-5), a county board may enact by ordinance or resolution a fee to finance a child advocacy center providing services in a county; and

WHEREAS, the Two Rivers Child Advocacy Center provides services in Union County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois has determined that Section 2 of Article 12 of Chapter 36 should be amended to provide funding to Two Rivers Child Advocacy Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF UNION, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Union County Code of Ordinances is hereby deleting Section 2 of Article 12 of Chapter 36 in its entirety and replacing Section 2 of Article 12 of Chapter 36 as follows:


36-12-3 CHILD ADVOCACY FEES. The Circuit Clerk shall collect additional fees as follows:

- (A) A fee of \$30 to be paid by the defendant on a judgment of guilty or a grant of supervision under Section 5-9-1 of the Unified Code of Corrections for a felony; for a Class A, Class B, or Class C misdemeanor; for a petty offense; and for a business offense.
- (B) Fees collected pursuant to this Section shall be collected by the Union County Circuit Clerk and must be deposited into an account specifically for the operation and administration of the Two River's Child Advocacy Center. The Union County Circuit Clerk shall collect the fees as provided in this Section, and must remit the fees to the Two Rivers Child Advocacy Center on a monthly basis.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

SECTION 3: The County Clerk shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance to the Circuit Clerk, the Treasurer and the Two Rivers Child Advocacy Center.
