

**AMENDMENT OF
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MANDATORY COURT FEE
FOR THE OPERATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF
TWO RIVERS CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER**

THIS RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED FOR THE PURPOSES OF ESTABLISHING COURT FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH 55 ILCS 5/5-1101(F-5) FOR THE OPERATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF TWO RIVERS CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER LOCATED IN ANNA, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Illinois adopted an amendment to the Counties Code allowing each county in which a Children's Advocacy Center provides services to adopt a mandatory fee of between Five Dollars (\$5.00) and Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) as found at 55 ILCS 5/5-1101(f-5); and

WHEREAS, the amendment to the Act allows that the fee shall be assessed for any judgment of guilty or grant of supervision under Section 5-9-1 of the Unified Code of Corrections for a felony, Class A misdemeanor, Class B misdemeanor, Class C misdemeanor, petty offense, or business offense with all amounts being deposited into an account specifically for the operation and administration of the Children's Advocacy Center serving the County; and

WHEREAS, the Two River's Child Advocacy Center located in Anna, Union County, Illinois, provides services to child victims, the various police agencies serving the citizens of Union County, the Union County State's Attorney's Office, and the First Judicial Circuit Court serving Union County;

WHEREAS, the services provided by Two River's Child Advocacy Center are a valuable and needed necessity for Union County; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Board to amend and modify Resolution #06-2008 passed on July 21, 2008.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Union County Circuit Clerk shall collect additional fees on each judgment of guilty, conditional discharge, or grant of supervision under Section 5-9-1 of the Unified Code of Corrections accordingly as indicated for the following infractions:

1. For all felony and misdemeanor offenses as defined under the Illinois Compiled Statutes resulting in judgments of guilt, conditional discharge, or court supervision in the amount of Thirty (\$30.00) dollars as an additional court fee for each conviction.


All amounts collected by the Circuit Clerk shall be deposited by the treasurer into an account specifically for the operation and administration of the Two River's Child Center located in Anna, Union County, Illinois, and then to remit those fees to Two River's Child Advocacy Center on a monthly basis.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED:

That this Resolution shall be reviewed in One (1) year to assess the effectiveness of the provisions contained herein, including the operations of the adopted procedures and the amount of funding raised for support and operation of Two River's Child Advocacy Center. However, failure to review or to act in One (1) years time shall not void this Resolution.




