**RESOLUTION SUBMITTING REFERENDUM TO THE VOTERS OF UNION  
COUNTY TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
SHALL CONSIST OF FIVE (5) COMMISSIONERS ELECTED AT LARGE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois (the "Board") consists of three (3) members elected at large; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/2-4006(c-5), the registered voters of Union County may, upon referendum initiated by the adoption of a resolution of the board of county commissioners, determine that the board of county commissioners shall consist of five (5) commissioners elected at large; and

**WHEREAS**, certain members of the public have requested that the Board adopt a resolution submitting a referendum to the voters of Union County to determine whether the Board shall consist of five (5) commissioners elected at large; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that the voters of Union County should have the opportunity to determine whether the Board shall consist of five (5) commissioners elected at large; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/2-4006(c-5), in order to submit a referendum to the voters of Union County to determine whether the Board shall consist of five (5) commissioners elected at large, the Board must certify the question to the proper election authority, which must submit the question at an election in accordance with the general election law.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois as follows:

1. A referendum to determine whether the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois shall consist of five (5) commissioners elected at large shall be submitted to the voters of Union County at the November 2, 2010 General Election.
2. The referendum question to be submitted to the voters of Union County at the November 2, 2010 General Election shall read as follows:

Shall the board of county commissioners of the County of Union consist of five (5) commissioners elected at large?

3. The referendum question shall be certified to the Union County Clerk and the Union County Clerk shall submit the referendum question to the voters of Union County at the November 2, 2010 General Election in accordance with the general election law.
