RESOLUTION REGARDING USE OF PROJECT AGREEMENTS  
ON COUNTY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

WHEREAS, Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois (the "Board") finds that it is in the best interest of the residents of Union County to have opportunities for gainful employment; and

WHEREAS, such residents may be entitled to employment opportunities on various construction projects undertaken by the County of Union, Illinois (the "County");

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Board to award its construction projects to employers that will not only provide sufficient employment for our citizens, but will guarantee to such citizens a decent wage and provide decent working conditions; and

WHEREAS, such construction projects should be performed by workers who are skilled in their respective crafts; and

WHEREAS, it is of importance to the Board to provide for labor peace and stability so that projects undertaken by the County may be completed as expeditiously and harmoniously as is possible;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois as follows:

Any and all construction projects with an estimated cost over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) performed for, or on behalf of, the County of Union, Illinois be performed under project agreements with employers that employ skilled employees that are represented by affiliates of the Egyptian Building and Construction Trades Council for the purpose of providing our citizens with decent wages and working conditions, and further providing that the said projects be performed with labor peace and harmony and by qualified and skilled craftsmen and craftswomen.
