**RESOLUTION VACATING TR 129A, RUMFELT LANE, AT THE
HIGHWAY-RAIL GRADE CROSSING OF THE UNION
PACIFIC RAILROAD'S TRACK NEAR WOLF LAKE, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois has determined that the public interest will be served by vacating TR 129A, Rumfelt Lane, from Illinois Route 3, easterly to its terminus for a distance of 1,100 feet, approximately 0.21 miles, and such road being located in Township 12 South, Range 3 West, Section 10 in Union County, Illinois. Vacation includes the point that TR 129A, Rumfelt Lane, is crossed by the Union Pacific Railroad's track, such intersection being:

The intersection of Union Pacific Railroad's track and TR 129A, Rumfelt Lane, identified as AAR/DOT#445 846F railroad milepost 100.95-A

and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois has determined that the statutorily dedicated portion of TR 129A, Rumfelt Lane serves no current or future public purpose and is currently a hazard to public health and safety;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: The recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference as if set out in full herein.

Section 2: The Union County Highway Engineer/Superintendent of Highways is directed to prepare a Memorandum of Decision that will cause the following to be vacated:


TR 129A, Rumfelt Lane, from Illinois Route 3, easterly to its terminus for a distance of 1,100 feet, approximately 0.21 miles. This road is located in Township 12 South, Range 3 West, Section 10 in Union County, Illinois. Vacation includes the point that TR 129A, Rumfelt Lane, is crossed by the Union Pacific Railroad's track, such intersection being:

The intersection of Union Pacific Railroad's track and TR 129A, Rumfelt Lane, identified as AAR/DOT#445 846F railroad milepost 100.95-A.


Section 3: The final vacation of the roadway will not take place until an Illinois Commerce Commission Order has been issued authorizing an incentive payment from the Grade Crossing Protection Fund. The Union County Highway Engineer/Superintendent of Highways will then record the Memorandum of Decision with the Union County Clerk and the Illinois Department of Transportation within five days.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
