**RESOLUTION INCREASING THE ESTABLISHED COURT AUTOMATION
FEE**

WHEREAS, 705 ILCS 105/27.3a of the Illinois Compiled Statutes as originally adopted provides for the Clerk of the Circuit Court to charge and collect a court automated recordkeeping fee of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$5.00 to defray the expense of maintaining a viable court automated recordkeeping system, and

WHEREAS, Public Act 94-596 was adopted and passed by the Illinois General Assembly such that effective January 1, 2006, 705 ILCS 105/27.3a was amended to increase the maximum rate of fees collected for document storage from \$5.00 to \$15.00, and

WHEREAS, Public Act 98-606 was adopted and passed by the Illinois General Assembly such that effective June 1, 2014, 705 ILCS 105/27.3a was amended to increase the maximum rate of fees collected for automated recordkeeping from \$15.00 to \$25.00, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union have the authority to approve the establishment of the court automated recordkeeping fee to be charged and collected by the Clerk of the Circuit Court.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, that the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Union County, Illinois, is required to charge and collect the sum of \$25.00 from parties in applicable court cases to be remitted and dispersed for the purpose of automated recordkeeping as provided in the Clerks of the Court Act, 705ILCS 105/27.3a to be effective immediately upon passage of this Resolution.
