**RESOLUTION ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT TO ANNUALLY
REAPPLY FOR HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION**

WHEREAS, 35 ILCS 200/15-170 provides for property that is occupied as a residence by a person sixty-five (65) years or older who is liable for paying real estate taxes on the property and is an owner of record of the property may be granted a Senior Citizens Homestead Exemption; and

WHEREAS, the chief county assessment officer of each county shall determine the eligibility of residential property to receive the homestead exemption; and


WHEREAS, the county board may by resolution provide that if a person has been granted a homestead exemption, the person qualifying need not reapply for the exemption.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Union, that the chief county assessment officer, the Supervisor of Assessments, may eliminate the requirement for persons qualifying for the Senior Citizens Homestead Exemption to reapply for exemption on an annual basis to be effective immediately upon passage of this Resolution.
